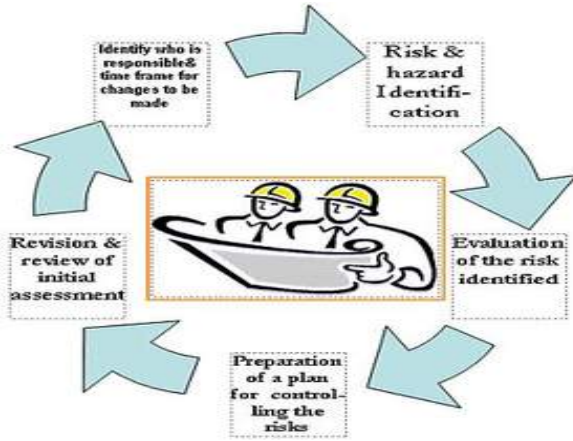

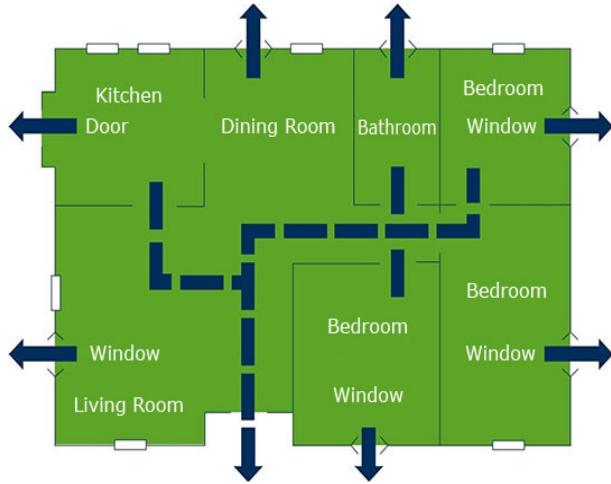

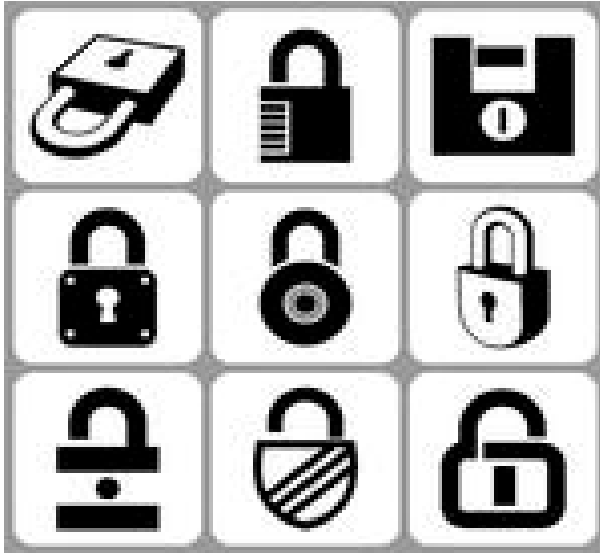
The purpose of fire doors and the importance of keeping fire doors closed to prevent the spread of fire, heat and smoke.
